



ORCHESTRA






LOWER BALCONY

STAIR ONLY ACCESS






LOCATION

The Historic Academy Theatre is located at 524 Main Street, at the corner of Fifth and Main Street, in Downtown Lynchburg, Virginia, just off of US-29 S, Exit 1A.

The public entrance to the Historic Academy Theatre can be found at the lobby entrance on Main Street, located underneath the 'Academy' Blade sign.






LOADING DOCK

All load-ins will take place from the loading dock, located on the left side of the Historic Academy Theatre, off of Fifth Street.

The loading dock can accommodate two (2) vehicles at a time.

Two (2) roll up doors 7'6" wide x 9' high lead from loading dock, through a staging area, to one (1) 10' wide x 9' high double door onto the SR portion of the stage.

Total distance from truck to stage is approximately 15'.

Floor Construction:

Sprung, black 1/4" Masonite surface over two (2) layers of 5/8" plywood on PermaFlex II sleepers with integral stop blocks (16" centers).

Orchestra Pit / Pit Lift:

Gala Systems Pit Lift

Pit platform is 9'1" deep at center x 39'2" wide. When platform is at pit level, the orchestra pit is 20'5" deep at center x 36' wide.

Total travel distance from stage level to storage level is 18'11.5".

Adjustable Acoustics:

The auditorium has motorized adjustable banners along the HL and HR walls as well as manual curtains on the back wall of the orchestra level, second balcony, and orchestra pit. Control for the motorized banners is located DSR.

Counterweight Rigging:

Rigging system consists of 45 single purchase counterweight line sets with 46' long battens with 3' extensions and line set capacity of 1200# each, unless otherwise noted. Max out trim is 62'-0".

POWER

Five (5) Company Switches are available around the perimeter of the stage to accommodate dimming and power distribution devices for touring applications. Each Company Switch has a connection chamber with shunt-trip access door and utilizes cam-lock type connectors made up of A phase, B Phase, C Phase, Neutral, Neutral, and Reverse Ground.

ELECTRICS/LIGHTING SYSTEM

Installed Performance Power and Controls:

The Performance Power and Controls system is comprised of two (2) Lyntec RPC DMX-Controlled Relay panels that are hard-wired to various locations in the theatre. There are also Busways (noted above) on galleries that are switched with the lighting power and used to power on stage electrics and booms.

Circuit distribution is a mix of various busway connections and switched single circuit 20A Stagepin connectors on outlet boxes and connector strips. (66) Performance circuits are hard-wired DMX-Controlled relays.

The control system is a network-based system, utilizing ETC Net3/ACN, RDM, and DMX. Portable DMX Gateways may be plugged into any available lighting network port location, allowing conversion of ACN to DMX. The network is capable of powering IEEE 802.3 standard compliant "Power Over Ethernet" Devices (P.O.E.)

SOUND AND COMMUNICATION SYSTEM

Sound Power:

There is isolated ground sound power throughout the facility, including the one (1) company switched noted above. IG convenience outlets are orange and marked with a triangle. Equipment tying into the house sound system must get power from these outlets to avoid a ground loop.

Mix Position:

House mix position is located in the orchestra level on HR, just in front of the cross aisle.

An alternate mix position is located in the front of the 1st balcony on HR, approximately 45' from the front of the stage.

Consoles and Snakes:

The house mixer is a Yamaha CL5 and (3) portable Rio1608-D stage boxes. The mixer digitally feeds signal to the DSP.

Touring consoles may be plugged into house PA at balcony or orchestra level mix position and downstage left.

DSP:

The house DSP takes main speaker feeds and relay feeds, process them and feeds them to house speaker positions, including fill and delay speakers. This signal may also be routed to the relay system and the ALS system.

Assisted Listening System:

Williams LT-800 FM System with (30) headset receivers and (8) induction loop receivers. This system is equalized and compressed in the DSP and fed the same source as backstage relay signal.

Backstage Relay and Paging:

The backstage relay signal may be fed from a dedicated signal from the house console, a dedicated feed from a touring console, from the Left, center and right channels feeding the main speakers or from dedicated monitor microphones.

This signal is fed via 70v distribution to dressing rooms, backstage areas, the lobby and the control booth.

The stage manager may individually select and page the house, backstage or the lobby via their intercom headset. This page overrides the volume controls in the dressing rooms.



<u>CHORAL DRESSING ROOMS (2):</u> Located below stage level. Complete with mirrors, chairs, lights, three (3) sinks, one (1) toilet, and one (1) shower. These rooms' capacity varies in range from 10 - 15 performers.

<u>KITCHENETTE (1):</u> Located below stage level to the left of the star dressing rooms. Complete with one (1) small refrigerator, one (1) microwave, one (1) coffee machine, and a sink. One (1) small café dining table and two (2) chairs are located in close proximity.






Multi-purpose Room:
